WHAT IS THE NDIS?

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) is a new way of providing support and services for people with disability or significant impairment under the age of 65. We have a range of approved NDIS services to help support you to live well.



PRE-PLANNING is all about ensuring you are supported to understand the NDIS and what that means for you, including what information you need to provide and knowing what to ask for when you decide to access the scheme.

Some of the problems pre-planning can help address:

- stress and confusion
- anxiety
- feeling overwhelmed by the NDIS
- decision-making
- lack of knowledge on the NDIS
